



AVScreenMaskTM

Installation Guidelines

Use the film orientation sampler against the PC screen to be cloaked, to determine if the film is applied vertically, horizontally or angled on the glass.

AVScreenMaskTM has a top protective layer designed to help against scratched during the install process. This is removed after installation but can interfere with the cloaking effect on the screen until removed. If in any doubt as to the orientation, then use a small piece of the film with both the backing sheet and protective overlayer removed, to determine the correct orientation.

- 1. Clean glass as normal with detergent and water solution and window wipe
- 2. Cut film to approximate finished size required. The film can be trimmed on the glass as required.
- 3. Wet glass with detergent / water mounting solution (same slip as required on a 7mil installation)
- 4. Remove the adhesive protection layer from the film and wet the adhesive. This adhesive is a PVA based one and allows more time to work with than the Cellulose ones of Casper and Data Jammer.
- 5. Line up the machined edge of the film with the vertical side of the glass or the horizontal of a laser guide, depending on orientation.
- 6. Hold firmly in position and use a blue hard squeegee or 6" hard block squeegee to push the water out. Advice is to go horizontally and overlap each stroke to remove the water, so as not to leave water bubbles. The bubbles will dry but the film has a heavy coating of metals and thus takes a long time for water residue to cure through the film.
- 7. Trim the sides and top of the film as required. The film can be cut to exact size, if this is easier for you to install or the glass is soft coated and liable to be scratched easily.
- 8. Dry edges as normal and if necessary, use a small hard card around the edges.
- 9. Leave for approximately an hour before removing the top protective layer. This uses a static cling adhesion method, so leaves no adhesive on the top surface of the film but should be removed carefully, so as to avoid lifting the AVScreenMaskTM
